

Building Repair Status

As I write this, it has been five months since our Christmas Eve building As I write this, it has been five months since our Christmas Eve building flood caused by the ruptured sprinkler system pipe. It is my hope that by the time you read this in June that all the building repairs will be com-pleted. With a week and a half left in May, there only remains some base board to be installed and clean up of construction debris including strip-ping and waxing of tile floors. Once this is complete, we will do a walk through with our contractor and develop a punch out list for items that might have been overlooked.

Over the course of the last five months the following items were completed. • Several weeks mitigation (this consist of removing damaged material and drying out all areas to avoid mold and mildew

• Replacing drywall, carpet, ceiling tiles, and several light fixtures with state-of-the art LED fixtures

- Priming and putting two coats of paint on all damaged walls
 New base board for all dry wall repaired
- Removal of debris

During all this time we have been able to continue our normal activities. It has required some rearrangements and patience, but we've made it work. Thanks to Glenn and the choir for adjusting their rehearsal loca-tion and everything that goes with that. Thanks to several Sunday school classes for graciously sharing their space. Most especially thanks to Lana and Samantha and the Preschool staff for their quick response as their entire operation was impacted and they didn't miss a beat. Amazing. And thanks to the entire church for adjusting your Sunday routine during this time. this time.


