# School Snack Pack Program

During the holiday season we are often reminded to be aware of children and families who are less fortunate and face hunger daily. Sadly, everyday children right here in Pickens County deal with issues of need that most of us have never experienced. Every school child has access to breakfast and lunch during weekdays, but many lose most of their nourishment during the weekend.

We are grateful for the generosity and support First Baptist Church has shown to these children through donations to the Weekend Snack Program. You currently supply a family size Mac and Cheese on a monthly basis along with other individual size snacks and your recycled grocery bags. Rising food costs and availability has become a growing challenge. The program cannot function without consistent, reliable donors like you. Thank you! Sustaining this mission of providing more than 600 snack bags each week is no small task. Once the food items have been secured through many hours of planning, shopping, phone calls and personal contacts the weekly sorting and scheduling begins. The regular volunteers who happily meet two days each week are senior citizens, home school families and a few college students who have a love for children. Some of these dedicated people have been on the assembly line since the program began. After the bags are filled and ready, they are delivered to every public school in the county plus the Head Start Program.

These volunteers know that this bag of snacks will help keep many children from being hungry until they return to school each Monday. Stop and think about that. A typical snack bag could be a can of Vienna sausage, two Pop Tarts, two servings of dry cereal, a granola bar, a small bag of chips, and a sleeve of saltine crackers. Some of the children who have a bag of similar items placed in their backpacks each Friday know it will supplement the weekend food for their entire family.
