*Spring Forward*



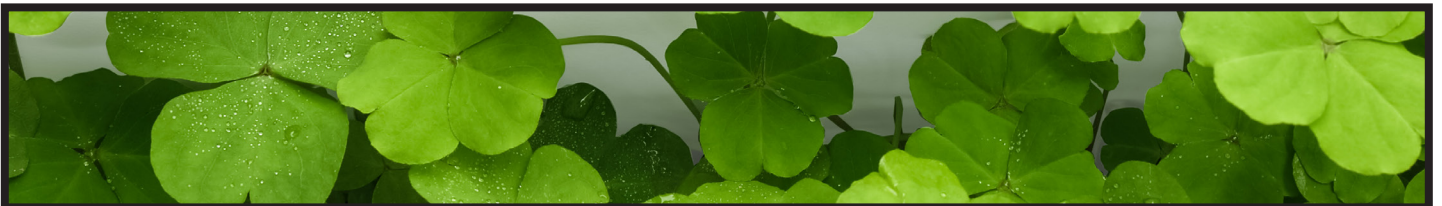
Over the month of February more work has been done on the Pavilion. It is looking really nice. As you look at the picture you will notice:
